AMANECER'S MISS UNIVERSE 2018

[INTRODUCTION – Welcoming to the event]

Commentator 1 [Juan Camilo Oviedo]: Tonight, 19 of the world's most incredible women go head to head for the ultimate prize: the Miss Universe crown! All eyes are on the bright lights of Amanecer School in Bogotá D.C.

This is Miss Universe 2018. Featuring backstage reports from Khalil Jusef Hamad and Sarah Sofía Gómez. In addition, live performances by Daniela Ruiz and Maluma.

Now, please welcome your host Juan Andrés Cano!

[Cheering, applause, screaming. Juan Andrés Cano enters through the 19 contestants]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Hello everybody I am your man Steve Harvey. Please, be welcomed to Miss Universe.

Well, my first year we started right here in Las Vegas. We all know how it all went! We do not really need to go back into that. At last, the big winner of Miss Universe was Miss South Africa. We had an amazing time!

[Cheering and screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Now we are back in one of the greatest cities in the world... Bogotá D.C.! In addition, this year, we are breaking records, because we have more Miss Universe contestants than ever before: 19 and we are going to need a lot more space on stage! It is a worldwide battle right here!

Here again, to help us up tonight is our backstage correspondent, beauty icon Sarah Sofía Gómez she will be bringing us all the inside info of tonight's competition, back up with no one, but Khalil Jusef Hamad, a pageant expert.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: That is right Juan Andrés! Throughout the night, I will be getting in depth analyses from our very own legendary fashion guru and top Broadway coach Khalil Jusef Hamad.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Hello!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: You look phenomenal tonight!

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Thank you! So do you.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: How do you feel?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: You know? I am super excited to be here! I get to be here, and it is really... It is the Super bowl of style. It is hair, is makeup, is glamorous, and is gowns. Therefore, I am thrill! I am so excited, and this year the competition is off the chain! The groups are ready and they have come to fight.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: All right Juan Andrés, back to you.

[FIRST PART – The Americas]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Well, thank you people! Miss Universe is truly and international competition, so this year we are changing things up! Tonight, for the first time, countries will be separated into three groups based on the geography. Group one in the Americas group. Group 2 is Europe. Group 3 is Africa and Asia Pacific. For the Americas, you are going to meet 11 contestants. For Europe, you will meet four contestants, and finally you will meet four contestants that do come from Africa and Asia Pacific combined. Women from each group are guaranteed to move on to the finals, to the top seven. Ok?

Now, it is time to get through it. Here in Bogotá D.C., let us start with the first region, the Americas.

[Cheering and applause. Music background. The remaining contestants walk down the stage and leave. The Americas contestants remain and walk through the stage]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Brazil!

Contestant A [Brazil – Amasty]: Hello! I am Amasty and I am representing the beautiful country of Brazil!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Canada!

Contestant B [Canada – Pamela]: Good evening everyone! It is amazing to be here. I am Pamela, Miss Canada. I will be honour to be your next Miss Universe

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Chile!

Contestant C [Chile – Luciana]: Hello you all! I am Luciana. I am Miss Chile. I love you all.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Colombia!

Contestant D [Colombia – Sara Güisa]: Hi! I am Sara. I am From Colombia.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Costa Rica!

Contestant E [Costa Rica – María Alejandra Morales]: Good evening! I am María Alejandra and I am representing Costa Rica.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Cuba!

Contestant F [Cuba – María Camila]: Hello, hello! I am María Camila and I come from the beautiful and extraordinary island of Cuba.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Greenland!

Contestant G [Greenland – Sara Castillo]: Hello! I am Sara. I am Miss Greenland.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Honduras!

Contestant H [Honduras – Juana Isabella]: Hi you all! I am Isabella. I am Miss Honduras. I am exciting to be here.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Mexico!

Contestant I [Mexico – Manuela Garzón]: Hello! I am Manuela, Miss Mexico. I am looking forward to show you a part of my country and to have fun. Thank you for this opportunity.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: USA!

Contestant J [USA – Kenia]: Hello! I am Kenia. I come from USA, from New York. I like my country and I am proud to be here.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Venezuela!

Contestant K [Venezuela – Channel]: Hi! I am Channel. I am Miss Venezuela. Beautiful country, beautiful people.

[Each contestant walks down the stage. Cheering and applauses]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: There are 11 women fighting to catch the spots in their region. It is a battle for the western hemisphere within the Americas. Here are Sarah Sofía and Khalil with the breakdown!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Thank you Juan Andrés! Khalil that was the first time that the contestants are on the stage.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Yes!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: What are they going through?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: They came to rehearse, they came to like, to make friends. Now comes the competition and the Americas set the bar that everyone else is trying to reach!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: I believe you, I really do. Ok Khalil, what do you love about this region?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Oh! Well, it is all about the Americas, I mean, 34 out of 65 Miss Universe winners have come from either North or South America, so the odds are on the Americas to take the title.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Sounds like you are into numbers.

Correspondent 3 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Well, I love Venezuela!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: I would say my favourite one from this region, so far is Colombia. She is amazing!

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: We have Cuba; we have Mexico, Chile, USA... all of them are rocking!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Ok, so we are back with you Juan Andrés!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thanks Sarah Sofía. We have met all the contestants from the Americas, but we got still two more groups ready to take the stage. Next up, we are going to cross the Atlantic and meet the contestants from Europe. This is Miss Universe 2018!

[Cheering, applauses, screaming]

[Video with photos, music and videos of the countries from the Americas]

[SECOND PART – Europe]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Welcome back to Miss Universe! We have seen the Americas on the stage and right now, it is Europe's turn to show the world what they have gotten. Please welcome the contestants from Europe.

[Cheering and applauses. Music background. The Americas contestants walk down the stage and leave. Europe's contestants appear on stage]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Germany!

Contestant L [Germany – Juanita]: Hallo you all! I am Juanita. I come from Germany, from Stuttgart. I am Miss Germany. *Viel Glück für alle!* Good luck everyone!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Italy!

Contestant M [Italy – Keyla Gómez]: Hi! I am Keyla. I am Miss Italy. I love pizza and pasta.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Russia!

Contestant N [Russia – Danna Orozco]: Hello! I am Danna Isabela. I am Miss Russia. I like being here, is hotter than my country. I practice gymnastics and ballet. I hope to be one of the finalists and I am confident about myself.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Spain!

Contestant O [Spain – Marina Ramírez]: Hello everyone! I am Mariana. I am from Madrid, Spain. I am glad to be here. I love paella and orange juice.

[Each contestant walks down the stage. Cheering and applauses]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Another outstanding group of women, but only some of them are guaranteed spots in the next round. Here is Sarah Sofía and Khalil to give us their commentaries of the Europe group.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Thank you Juan Andrés! Ok people, we just saw Europe contestants and this region had just two years ago one girl that won.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Yes, France! Europe traditionally does really rock it all the time in Miss Universe, with fact and figures in one of every seven times, in fifty years. They look at the other two groups and they say: "you know what? They came to rock and roll, so Europe is going to be present too". Actually, I have many favourites from this group.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Please, tell us who they are.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: I like Spain, Russia and Italy!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Ok! What about you Khalil?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Please, do not count out Germany! This is the best Germany contestant we have had in quite some time. This Europeans set goals. I love them!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Ok! Right back to you Juan Andrés!

Interviewer 1 [Julián]: You know? Wearing a crown is a great honour, but also comes with a lot of hard work and responsibility. Our last Miss Universe analyst Juan Andrés Carrillo Tobón has been helping pageant contestant to fulfil their duties with grace, confidence and determination. Let us take a look on his work.

[Interview with the analyst Juan Andrés Carrillo Tobón]

Interviewer 1 [Julián]: You are truly an impressive man, mister Carrillo. It is great to see you again. You are one of the most hardworking analysts in the world and you are helping pageant to make awareness of the importance to strength women of the world. How do you feel about your work?

Interviewer 2 [Juan Andrés Carrillo]: Thank you very much. Indeed it has been a truly honour to be here and work in an organisation that helps empowering women worldwide. It is hard to believe how far we have come, but the commitment of everyone is undeniable. This last year was a wonderful year, and I hope the ones to follow continue like that.

Interviewer 1 [Julián]: Thank you mister Carrillo, so much. You are here tonight, but I know you were also throughout last few years, and this is partly because of you that we are all here tonight. I wish you good luck and encourage you to continue doing this incredible job. Thank you.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: We have met the contestants from the Americas and Europe. Next, we will cover the next of the world. In few minutes, the women of Africa and Asian Pacific will hit the stage, as we meet our final group of the night. This is Miss Universe 2018 live on Amanecer School!

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

[Video with photos, music and videos of the countries from Europe]

[THIRD PART – Africa and Asian Pacific]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Welcome back to Miss Universe everybody! So far, we have seen contestants from two groups, the Americas and Europe. Next one will be group three, Africa and Asian Pacific. Now, let us meet all of the contestants of Africa and Asian Pacific.

[Cheering and applause. Music background. Europe contestants walk down the stage and leave. Africa and Asian Pacific contestants appear on stage]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Australia!

Contestant P [Australia – Gabriela]: Hello! I am Gabriela. I come from the Land down under, Australia. My favourite animal is the kangaroo and I am protecting the koalas. Thank you!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: China!

Contestant Q [China – Danna Orjuela]: Hello everyone! I am Danna. I am from Beijing, China. I speak Chinese, English and a little bit of Spanish.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: India!

Contestant R [India – Lina Isabella]: Hi! I am Miss India. My name is Lina. I am from New Delhi. I love eating samosas and lentils.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: South Africa!

Contestant S [South Africa – Sara Güisa]: Hi! I am Sara. I am Miss South Africa.

[Each contestant walks down the stage. Cheering and applause]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: At least four of these contestants will have the chance to make their dreams come true tonight. Here is Sarah Sofía and Khalil to give us an insight look.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: All right people! We have three new countries in this region. Khalil, I want to know, what are the advantages and disadvantages of being a new contestant?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: The advantages are you are new; you are fresh. The disadvantages are that you have no one to tell you what you are going to be facing; what you should do, expect and look up, for.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: They are really talented girls! Khalil, how are you feeling overall, about this region?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: This region is strong! They have crown after crown.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: I would have to say that my favourite is South Africa. She is rocking, beautiful and intelligent. So as the other girls.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: But do not sleep on China!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: All right Juan Andrés, back to you.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you Sarah Sofía. We have already made history tonight with the most countries ever represented in here. Next the results of our judges for the final sixteen.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

[Video with photos, music and videos of the countries from Africa and Asian Pacific]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Coming up is the first elimination and the performances from Daniela Ruiz and Maluma. This is the first Miss Universe in 2018 live from Amanecer School in Bogotá D.C.

[FOURTH PART – Finalists]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Welcome back everybody. For the contestants the competition began over a week ago, from the moment they stepped out of the plane here in Bogotá. They immediately went head to head in the preliminary competition where the pressure was on, right from the very start.

[Video of the contestants rehearsing for the show]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: As though as the preliminaries were, it is nothing compare to what is on stage for contestants tonight. Right now, let us meet our judges. This group of judges have to make a tough decision tonight.

Please, say hello to Martín, Sebastián Cagüañas, Angel, Roger and Jorge, our judges.

Judge 1 [Martín]: Hello! I am Martín. I like smile, confidence and attitude.

Judge 2 [Sebastian Cagüañas]: Hello! I am Sebastian Cagüañas and intelligence is a must.

Judge 3 [Angel]: Hi! I am Angel and you must speak amazing!

Judge 4 [Roger]: Hello! I am Roger. Creativity and imagination on stage, please!

Judge 5 [Jorge]: Hello! I am Jorge. I see passion and culture from every country.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Early on this week a preliminary panel of judges, all of you voting at home, and some people from the Miss Universe organisation selected seven finalists. You have met all the contestants. Here are your first finalists.

The first contestant from Africa and Asian Pacific, heading to the top sixteen is South Africa.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Congratulations. You own a Master degree in Marketing, worked as a Teacher and recorded an album. What is next on your list to do?

Contestant S [South Africa – Sara Güisa]: Thank you Juan Andrés. I will be the next Miss Universe.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you South Africa. Also moving forward is... China!

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Well, how are you?

Contestant Q [China – Danna Orjuela]: I am fantastic!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: I understand that you have eight cats. What are their names?

Contestant Q [China – Danna Orjuela]: They are Coco, Nameless, Bullets, Toothless, Mama Kitty, Kiki, Tenacious and Dragon.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Congratulations China. Now, the final selection from this group is... Australia!

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: How are you?

Contestant P [Australia - Gabriela]: Oh my goodness. I could not be happier Juan Andrés.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: You probably imagine what I am going to ask you. I heard that you have a pet lion. Is that right?

Contestant P [Australia Gabriela]: Yes, that is right. I have a lion pet. His name is Bengi.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: These are our first finalists. We have four more to announce. Up next, we will reveal the finalists of Europe and the Americas. Do not miss a moment.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Our next finalists from the Europe group. Here we go. The first from Europe to advance is... Spain.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: How are you?

Contestant O [Spain – Mariana Ramírez]: Good evening Bogotá, I am so happy to be here.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: You are probably aware that your family is awoken since really early to see you in here. What do you want to say to them right now?

Contestant O [Spain – Mariana Ramírez]: To all my Spanish family out there, good morning! I love you all.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you Spain. The next spot goes to... Germany.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Congratulations how are you?

Contestant L [Germany - Juanita]: Fine, thank you very much. I am great!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: I understand that your grandmother is your biggest fan. What is the best advice she ever gave you?

Contestant L [Germany - Juanita]: It is that you never fail until you give up.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Absolutely. Thank you Germany. Congratulations.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: These women represent Europe as part of the finalists. Let us go with Sarah Sofía with some inside reactions.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Thank you Juan Andrés. So, the first finalists have been revealed! What are your thoughts?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: All of these participants are amazing! Fabulous all the way!

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: What is your predictions for the Americas?

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Oh! Oh! Let me think... USA -for sure-; Venezuela, Mexico and Colombia.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Yes, Colombia is out there winning for me. All right Juan Andrés, here you are with the results!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you Sarah Sofía! Right now, we are going to reveal the finalist from the Americas. Here we go.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: First from the Americas to advance is... Colombia.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: How are you?

Contestant D [Colombia – Mariana Hernández]: Fine, and you?

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: I have heard that as a child you memorize a lot of songs. Please, sing a part of a song.

Contestant D [Colombia – Mariana Hernández]: *[starts to sing a part of Colombia tierra querida]*

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Yes, Thank you Colombia. Only one spot left. Still in the competition is... Mexico.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Congratulations.

Contestant I [Mexico – Manuela Garzón]: Well, thanks to you.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: I understand that you like to swim with sharks. Why?

Contestant I [Mexico – Manuela Garzón]: I am not afraid of them. My mother taught me and we do that together. They are beautiful. I love them!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Sharks eat people, stay away from sharks! Thank you very much Mexico.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: There you have it, our finalists! Congratulations! They have worked hard to make it this far. However, the competition has just getting started. Now, let us check in with Sarah Sofía to know her thoughts and expectations.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Thank you Juan Andrés. Our top seven is an incredible group of women. I am excited to see how they are handling the competition. I have my favourites, but I keep it open-minded. All right Juan Andrés it is back to you!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you Sarah Sofía. Tonight's winner will be decided by our judges here and by all of your applause. So Angel, any surprises in the finalists?

Judge 3 [Angel]: Yes, there were a few surprises.

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you. Judges, the pressure is on with you tonight. What are you looking for?

Judge 1 [Martín]: Confidence, good heart, and intelligent

Judge 4 [Roger]: And an excellent role model!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Great! What is it like to be a judge? Is it hard?

Judge 2 [Sebastian Cagüeñas]: It is extraordinary!

Judge 5 [Jorge]: Harsh and fun!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Right, it is hard to be a judge. Thank you judges.

All of the contestants are incredible women that will continue to move on and make a difference in their community. All of them are going to do great things. All of the contestants are a huge and shining example of what it means to be confident, intelligent and beautiful.

[FIFTH PART – Artistic performance]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: For tonight's competition, hands up for an electrifying performance by eight time Grammy Award winner: Daniela Ruiz!

Singer 1 [Daniela Ruiz]: At a young age, I decided to pursue a career and a hobby, and now I am a singer and songwriter. I also broke stereotypes, because there has never been an entertainer as young as I am in Mexico. I became a singer and now I am representing my country Mexico, everywhere I go. I am positive about music bringing out the best of people. It gathers them together. It makes us happy. Music can truly change the world. There is no need to imitate, creativity is all around us and imagination is the way to make things tangible. I know that with dedication and hard work, we can accomplish anything in life.

[Cheering, applause, screaming]

[Song presented by Daniela Ruiz]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Please, show your love for Daniela! Let us hear the insight opinion of Sarah Sofía and Khalil.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Thanks Juan Andrés. Wow! I love this performance, it was vibrant, passionate, and it just combines perfectly with the mood right now.

Correspondent 2 [Khalil Jusef Hamad]: Sure, and the creativity and inspiration were there the whole time. It was Amazing! All right, take it away to you Juan Andrés.

[SIXTH PART – Artistic Performances - Dances]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: I invite you to be part of an artistic performance made by the contestants. Enjoy it!

[Cheering, applause, screaming. All the contestants participate in the dance performance show]

[SEVENTH PART – Questions, family Opinions and countries' information]

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Now that we know our finalists, it is time for the question lighting round. As we ask some questions to our finalists, as they are heading up to stage, we will be hearing some opinions from their relatives backstage. This is Miss Universe in Amanecer School 2018!

The first finalist to answer is... Colombia.

[Cheering, applause, screaming. As the participant steps up to the stage, the interview with her relatives is done]

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Ok Juan Andrés and viewers, we are here backstage with some of Colombia's relatives. Welcome sir, how are you?

Father 1 [Nicolás]: Hello! I am fine, thank you. What about you?

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Fine thanks. Therefore, you are Miss Colombia's father. How do you feel right now?

Father 1 [Nicolás]: I could not be happier. I am proud of her. Everything she has accomplished is because of her hard work and dedication. Best wishes for her.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: And who is here with you?

Father 1 [Nicolás]: My son, David.

Correspondent 1 [Sarah Sofía Gómez]: Hello David, are you excited to be here sending good luck to your sister?

Brother 1 [David – 1st grade]: Hi! Yes, I am extremely excited. This is a dream that comes true to my sister. We love you!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Well Colombia, what is the perfect gift Colombia gives to the Universe?

Contestant D [Colombia – Mariana Hernández]: Culture, dancing, nature and food!

Host 1 [Juan Andrés Cano]: Thank you Colombia.

[Cheering, applause and screaming]

Commentator 1 [Juan Camilo Oviedo]: Colombia is a country located in South America. Its landscape includes tropical rainforests, the Andes mountains chain and lots of coffee plantations. Some of its touristic places are: Amazonas and Amacayacu park, Putumayo, Meta, La Macarena, La Guajira, Playa del Pílon de Azúcar, Providencia island, Cartagena's historic centre, Popayán and its churches, Boyacá and its towns and villages, La Periquera waterfall, Cali's headlands.
